



090505 Press release – DANTE 2008, Borderlight No.1 for Transmission

Borderlight ranks No.1 in Transmission and 3rd overall in Swedish National Financial Management Authority's procurement of "DANTE 2008 – Fixed and Mobile operator services and Transmission" for all government departments, 17 regional hospitals and 200 municipalities. A total of 11 operators have been given contracts to deliver services at an estimated value of 1,9 billion SEK (180 MEuro) over the next 3 years.

This is primarily a great opportunity for new regional fibre networks and its associated metropolitan networks such as SkåNet, Västlänk, Wökby bredband, Stokab, Norrsken, AC Net and Lumiora, which play an important part in Borderlights offer.

The demand for close to 100% coverage within reasonable total costs is met by optimized coordination with traditional xDSL communication and fibre transmission from Telia International Carrier, Skanova (former Telecom monopole) and Interoute, combined with a close cooperation with Eltel Networks and its 2 200 employees to guarantee highest service level in 2 000 cities all over Sweden.

Borderlight offers leading edge experience in building and integrating data, voice and video in fibre based network with high capacity and reliability to public sector, enterprises and home users.
